INVITATION FOR BIDS

BID #: PW327 – On Call Road Rehabilitation

The Town of Framingham (Town), Department of Public Works (DPW), invites sealed bids for the rehabilitation of the asphalt surface courses, curbs and sidewalks, on public roads, and/or segments of public roads within the Town of Framingham. The work may consist of one or more or any combination of the following construction procedures as determined by the Town:

- remove and replace the existing asphalt surface course
- asphalt patching
- asphalt cement and cement concrete sidewalk construction
- wheelchair ramp construction to ADA requirements
- installation of stamped and colored concrete
- installation of stamped asphalt
- associated storm-drainage rehabilitation
- removal and resetting of granite curbing and edging as required, installation of asphalt cement curbs, installation of new granite curbing and edging
- adjustment of street castings to meet grade as required
- removal and application of temporary and permanent traffic markings
- maintenance of traffic signal operations, and replacing traffic control detection wire loops
- loam and seed

The work also contains improvements to the Mary E Stapleton School, located at 25 Elm Street, Framingham, MA 01701. The work may consist of one or any combination of the following construction procedures as determined by the Town:

- site grading
- remove and replace the existing asphalt surface course
- full depth roadway construction
- asphalt cement and cement concrete sidewalk construction
- wheelchair ramp construction to ADA requirements
- courtyard improvements including the installation of stamped and colored concrete

- installation of drainage collection system
- installation of leaching galleys
- retaining walls and seat walls
- chain link fence
- parking lot traffic markings
- loam and seed

THE MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (MASSDOT) HAS PROVIDED A LIST TO THE FRAMINGHAM PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OF APPROVED ELIGIBLE BIDDERS FOR THIS PROJECT. ONLY THOSE CONTRACTORS ON THIS LIST WILL RECEIVE OFFICIAL BID DOCUMENTS. ALL OTHERS WILL BE PROVIDED WITH AN INFORMATIONAL COPY.

Sealed bids shall be submitted in strict conformance with the bid document and will be received at 110 Western Avenue, Framingham, MA 01702 until 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 26, 2016.

Bid documents will be available for pick-up after 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 4, 2016 at the above location or by emailing DPWProcurement@FraminghamMa.gov.

The awarded contractor shall comply with Mass. Gen. L. Ch. 149, Sec. 26 – 27D, as this contract is subject to Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Rates.

The Town reserves the right to reject any and all submissions, to waive any minor informalities and technicalities, or to cancel the bid if it were in the public interest to do so.
