**BID #: PW329 – Downtown Common Improvements Project**

The Town of Framingham (Town), Department of Public Works (DPW), invites sealed bids to restore and improve the Downtown Common located at the intersection of Concord and Howard Streets and requires all work necessary or proper for or incidental to this project including providing all necessary supervisors, personnel, equipment, and materials. The Work may consist of, but is not limited to construction procedures including removal of trees and shrubs, protection of existing trees to remain, removal of certain brick paving areas, remove and reset a portion of the existing granite bollard, new granite bollards, new granite piers, new railing, remove and dispose of a portion of the existing seat wall, new brick pave walkways, new granite bands, new granite steps, new concrete sidewalks, new brick banding, remove and reset monuments, remove and dispose of existing flag pole, new flag pole, remove and stockpile existing lights, new ornamental lighting and associated electrical work, new benches, and new trees.

**Sealed bids shall be submitted in strict conformance with the bid document and will be received at 110 Western Avenue, Framingham, MA 01702 until 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, October 13, 2016.**
