Framingham, MA – The City of Framingham received seventeen (17) applications for five (5) seats on the licensing board of the seventeen (17) applications six were women, eleven (11) were men, four (4) were Spanish speakers and one (1) was a Portuguese speaker. The appointed commissioners consist of two (2) women, three (3) men, two (2) Spanish speakers, one (1) Portuguese speaker and represent the diversity of Framingham. Mayor Yvonne M. - Adam R. Barnosky, Esq. will serve a **two (2)** year term on the Board of License Commissioners and has been appointed **Chair**.
