

Site Remediation Project



350 Irving Street, Framingham

Starting in late March, 2016, Eversource will begin a six-week site remediation project at 350 Irving Street in Framingham to excavate the contents of a historic underground tar holder. Our work will be concentrated in the parking area, or southeast portion, of this property.

We are working closely with Town of Framingham officials and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection to complete this project. Eversource is committed to removing impacted materials in the safest and most environmentally responsible manner, and in compliance with all state laws.

Crews will be working Monday through Saturday from about 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, and access to the property will be maintained.

Work to be Completed

Eversource will be removing remaining materials inside a tar holder that was used by a former manufacturing gas plant located at this site from 1889 to 1967. The excavation area will be approximately 70 feet in diameter, and approximately 10 feet below ground. Soil will be excavated using standard excavating equipment and loaded directly onto trucks for off-site recycling. The area will then be back filled with clean soil and returned to its original state.

Eversource will work closely with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection to help implement control measures to suppress and monitor odors.
