1. Tag must be shown to Gate Attendant before entering Beach.
2. Tag must be visible at all times.
3. **Beach hours are:**  
**Monday - Sunday: 10:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.**  
**(gates are locked promptly at 7:00pm)**  
**June 21 - August 16, 2018**
4. Tags are valid at:  
Learned's Pond - Shawmut Terrace  
Saxonville Beach - Lake Road  
Lake Waushakum- Nipmuc Terrace
5. Rules at the Beach are attached and must be adhered to. Everyone must sign a waiver prior to entering the beach.
6. All persons 12 months and older must purchase a Day Pass or a Seasonal Pass.
7. The Department reserves the right to revoke beach tags.
8. NO REFUNDS for LOST TAGS.

## **BEACH RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Swim in designated area only. **No diving or head entry into the water!**
2. Any child under the age of nine must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible person age 18 or above. One responsible person shall supervise no more than three children.
3. No running or pushing on docks.
4. **Non-swimmers of all ages must remain in areas where they can stand and may be asked to perform, and pass, a swim test prior to being allowed in the deep end.**
5. Use of any flotation aides or swimming devices (including, but not limited to, PFD's, masks, fins, snorkels, water wings, etc.) is strictly **forbidden**.
6. No eating, smoking, or fishing on the docks or in the water.
7. Smoking or vaping is not allowed on beach or in bathhouse.
8. Beach area and docks may not be used as a launching / unloading area for any boat.
9. No loitering in or around bathhouse area.
10. **No alcoholic beverages allowed on City Beach property.**
11. No dogs / pets allowed on beach or in bathhouse.
12. No littering - trash must be put in receptacles.
13. No ball playing of any kind allowed in water, or near bathhouse.
14. Bicycles must be left at the bicycle stands.
15. Bathing attire must be worn and is subject to the discretion of the lifeguard. No nudity allowed.
16. No swimming under the docks, or areas that are designated as non-swimming.
17. All persons, *12 months and older*, are required to purchase a beach tag or pay a daily use fee to enter the facility.
18. Bathhouse facilities are available at all beaches. Please help keep our water clean, and use the facilities when needed.
19. **All children who are not toilet-trained MUST wear SWIM DIAPERS.**
20. Cookouts are not allowed on beach sand area.
21. No feeding wildlife at beaches. (fish, birds, geese, etc.)
22. No glass on the beach.
23. The use of car stereos is not allowed. Please use personal listening devices.
24. The City requires groups of 10 or more to apply for a group permit to use the beach.

**\* Continued abuse by any individual of the above rules will result in loss of beach privileges. \***
