

ORDER FOR JOINT OR IDENTICAL POLE LOCATION

By the City Council of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts notice having been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

That permission be and hereby granted **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** and **NSTAR ELECTRIC dba EVERSOURCE ENERGY** joint or identical locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles and their respective wires and cables to be placed thereon, together with anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Companies may deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to as requested in petition of said Companies dated the 14th day of February, 2018.

KENDALL STREET: Relocate one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.2/E.2 to a point on the northerly side of Kendall Street approximately three hundred twenty (320) feet easterly from the center line of Concord Street.

KENDALL STREET: Relocate one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.3/E.3 to a point on the northerly side of Kendall Street approximately four hundred forty (440) feet easterly from the center line of Concord Street.

KENDALL STREET: Relocate one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.4/E.4 to a point on the northerly side of Kendall Street approximately five hundred thirty-seven (537) feet easterly from the center line of Concord Street.


3 JO Poles to be relocated

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the conditions set forth in a letter dated March 16, 2018 from the Framingham Department of Public Works as well as the following general conditions:

Poles shall be of sound timber, and reasonably straight and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the Petition Plan marked – **VERIZON No. 4A0DQ7N**, dated February 14, 2018 filed with said petition and later revised. There may be attached to said poles by said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** not to exceed 20 wires and 5 cables and by said **NSTAR ELECTRIC dba EVERSOURCE ENERGY** such wires, cables and fixtures as are necessary in its business and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height in compliance with the National Electrical Safety Code.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted to the said Companies to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as may be desired for distributing purposes.

I hereby certify that the foregoing order was adopted at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts held on the 20th day of March 2018.

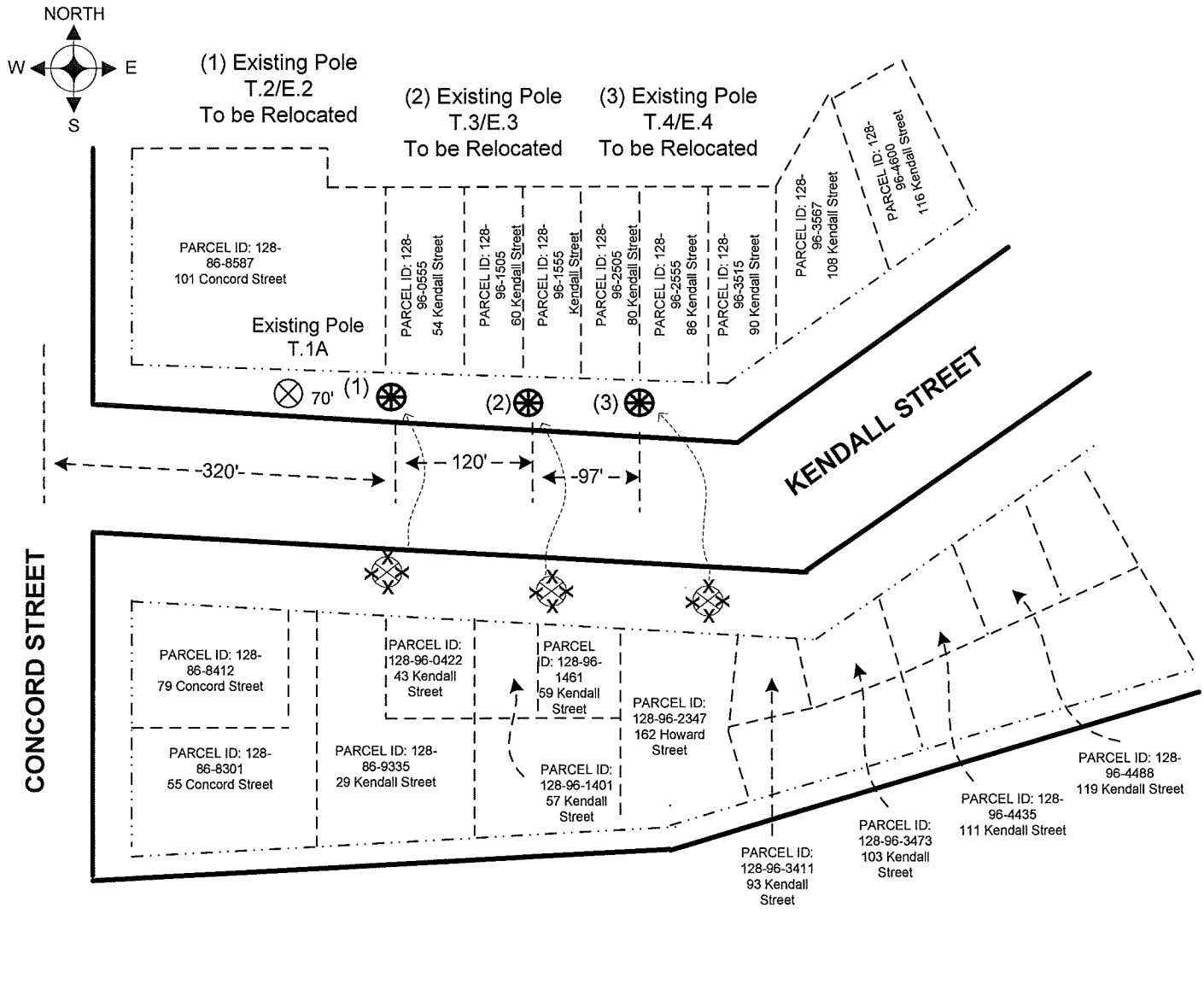

Re: Kendall Street - Grant of Location Request – Verizon job # 4A0DQ7N

Dear City Council,

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is in receipt of a request from Verizon New England, Inc. to relocate existing poles, wire, cables and fixtures, including the necessary anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures to be owned and used in common by your petitioners, along and across the following public way or ways of Kendall Street in support of relocating existing poles # T.2/E.2, T.3/E.3, and T.4/E.4.

We have reviewed this Grant of Location request submitted to the City Council and recommend approval subject to the following conditions:

1. The proposed location for one of the poles (T.2/E.2) is within 20 feet of an existing Verizon pole (labelled 120/1A) within the public right-of-way (ROW). The existing pole currently serves to hold wires as they travel down Kendall Street and service multiple properties. This existing pole will be redundant of the proposed relocated pole and, if they both remain, will provide unnecessary obstructions in the public ROW and visual blight. Therefore we suggest that the City Council grant this petition on the condition that the existing pole 120/1A is removed as part of this project.
2. The applicant shall call Dig-safe to mark out the location of the water main before construction.
3. The proposed utility pole (relocation) shall be installed a minimum five feet away from City utilities. The DPW requests notification prior to the start of work to verify final location in the field.
4. All work shall conform to the City of Framingham construction standards.
5. The proposed work shall be inspected by the City of Framingham DPW to verify that no public utilities are adversely affected.
6. The area in the vicinity of the work shall be restored and all excess excavation resulting from pole setting shall be removed by the Grantee.
