FRAMINGHAM, MA – Busy contractors in need of plumbing, gas, electrical, sheet metal, and shed permits can strike parking and standing in line at City Hall off of their to-do lists because they can now access and pay for them [online](#).

While not all permits can be paid for online, all can be accessed and printed. For those permits that can be paid for online, payment is by credit card only.
