ORDER FOR JOINT POLE LOCATION

By the City Council of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts notice having been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

That permission be and hereby granted **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC. and NSTAR ELECTRIC (EVERSOURCE)** joint or identical locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles and their respective wires and cables to be placed thereon, together with anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Companies may deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to as requested in petition of said Companies dated the 27th day of July, 2018.

HOWARD STREET: Place one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.5/E.7-1X on the southerly side of Howard Street approximately five hundred twenty (520) feet easterly from the center line of Concord Street.

HOWARD STREET: Place one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.7A/E.7A on the southerly side of Howard Street approximately six hundred sixty-one (661) feet easterly from the center line of Concord Street.


2 New JO Poles to be placed

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the conditions set forth in a letter dated August 3, 2018 from the Framingham Department of Public Works as well as the following general conditions:

Pole shall be of sound timber, and reasonably straight and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the Petition Plan marked – **VERIZON No. 4A0DQ7N**, dated July 25, 2018 filed with said petition. There may be attached to said poles by said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC. and NSTAR ELECTRIC (EVERSOURCE)** not to exceed 20 wires and 5 cables and by said any such wires, cables and fixtures as are necessary in its business and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height in compliance with the National Electrical Safety Code.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC. and NSTAR ELECTRIC (EVERSOURCE)** to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as may be desired for distributing purposes.

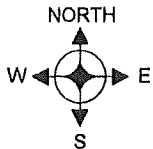

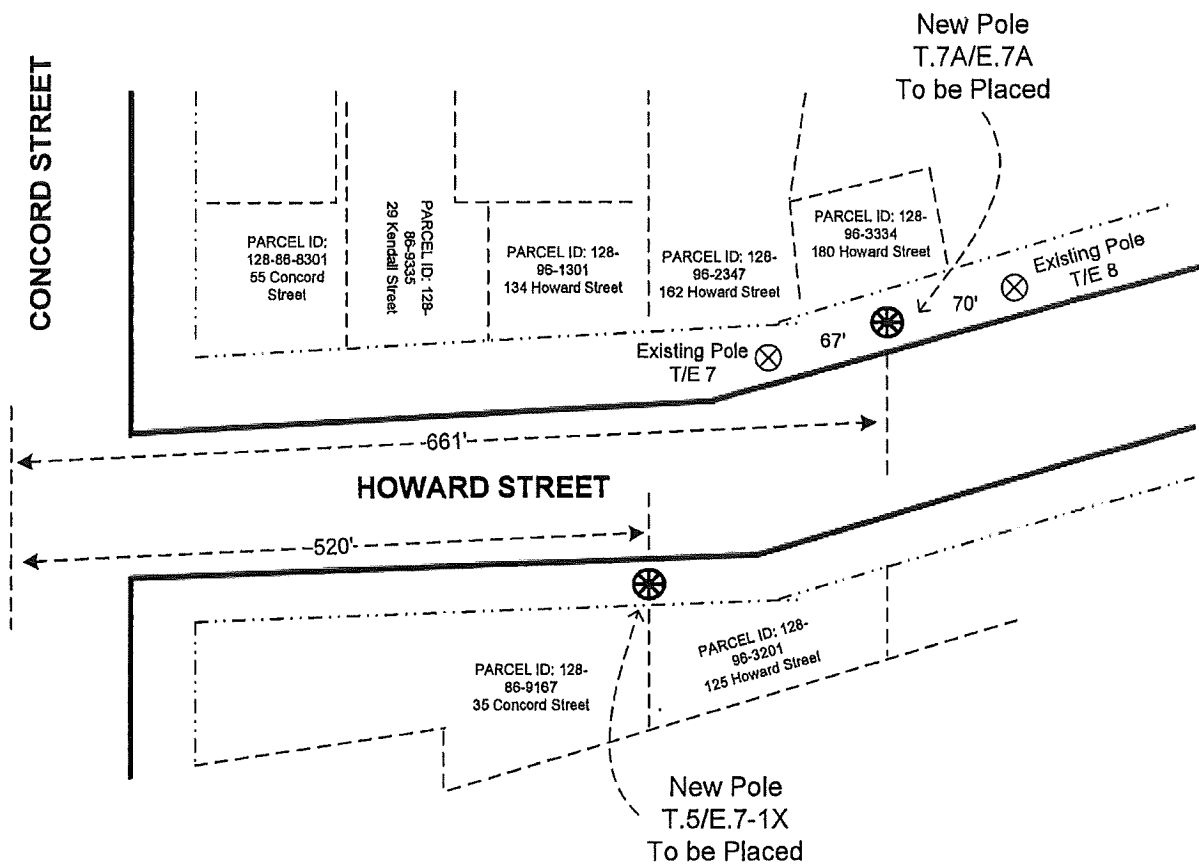

- - - EDGE OF PAVEMENT

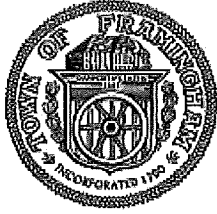
— EDGE OF ROAD

Dear City Council,

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is in receipt of a request from Verizon New England, Inc. to install new poles, wire, cables and fixtures, including the necessary anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures to be owned and used in common by your petitioners, along and across the following public way or ways of Howard Street in support of new jointly owned poles T.5.E.7-1X and T.7A/E.7A. This infrastructure will be located on the public way of Howard Street as represented under submitted Grant of Location application package dated July 27, 2018.

We have reviewed this Grant of Location request submitted to the City Council and recommend approval subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant shall call Dig-safe to mark out the location of the water main before construction.
2. The proposed utility pole (new) shall be installed a minimum five feet away from City utilities. The DPW requests notification prior to the start of work to verify final location in the field.
3. All work shall conform to the City of Framingham construction standards.
4. The proposed work shall be inspected by the City of Framingham DPW to verify that no public utilities are adversely affected.
5. The area in the vicinity of the work shall be restored and all excess excavation resulting from pole setting shall be removed by the Grantee.
