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ORDER FOR JOINT OR IDENTICAL POLE LOCATION

By the City Council of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts notice having been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

That permission be and hereby granted **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles and their respective wires and cables to be placed thereon, together with anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Companies may deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to as requested in petition of said Companies dated the 8th day of May, 2018.

It is noted that this work was previously approved in Order 2018-030; however, a change in pole location necessitated a new petition. Order 2018-030 is hereby vacated.

HOWARD STREET: Place one (1) solely owned pole numbered T.4 on the southerly side of Howard Street approximately three hundred sixty-five (365) feet easterly from the center line of Concord Street.


1 Pole to be placed

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the conditions set forth in a letter dated May 15, 2018 from the Framingham Department of Public Works as well as the following general conditions:

Pole shall be of sound timber, and reasonably straight and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the Petition Plan marked – **VERIZON No. 4A0DQ7N**, dated May 8, 2018 filed with said petition. There may be attached to said pole by said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** not to exceed 20 wires and 5 cables and by said any such wires, cables and fixtures as are necessary in its business and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height in compliance with the National Electrical Safety Code.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as may be desired for distributing purposes.



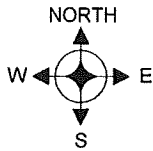

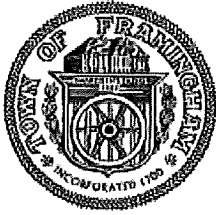

Dear City Council,

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is in receipt of a request from Verizon New England, Inc. to locate (1) four 4-inch conduit to be owned and maintained a total of +/- 177 feet of conduit as well as the revised location of utility pole T.4. This infrastructure will be located on the public way of Howard Street as represented under submitted Grant of Location application package dated May 8, 2018.

We have reviewed this Grant of Location request submitted to the City Council and recommend approval subject to the following conditions:

1. The proposed conduit shall be installed at the location as shown on the plan accompanying the petition. The Department requests notification prior to the start of work to verify final location in the field.
2. The conduits shall be encased in cement concrete.
3. The applicant shall obtain a Street Opening Permit for this work.
4. The applicant and contractor shall endeavor to maintain 10-foot separation from city-owned utilities at all times.
5. The proposed work shall be inspected by the City of Framingham DPW to verify that no public utilities are adversely affected.
6. The area in the vicinity of the work shall be restored and all excess excavation resulting from the conduit installation shall be removed by the Grantee.
7. All work shall conform to the City of Framingham construction standards.
