**Residents Invited to Discuss Proposal to Remove Out-of-date Billboards in Downtown Framingham
Thursday, October 24, at McAuliffe Branch Library**

Framingham, MA – Clear Channel Outdoor is working with the City of Framingham on a proposal that would include the removal of old out-of-date billboards in downtown Framingham.

In addition to removing the billboards, Clear Channel Outdoor is offering to make annual payments to the City and donate public service messages. In return, the City will support the Company's efforts to obtain necessary permits and approvals to allow for a new digital billboard to be located along the Massachusetts Turnpike at 500 Old Connecticut Path.
