BLACKBERRY LANE PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS

The City of Framingham (City), Department of Public Works (DPW), invites sealed bids for a project that includes furnishing all necessary labor, materials, and equipment to replace the existing sewage pump station with a new submersible pump station. The project shall include the installation of a submersible duplex pump system; maintaining flow conditions throughout the duration of the project; demolition and legal disposal of existing components; providing temporary by-pass pumping as needed; the abandonment of the existing pump station including all electrical systems; installation of new sections of gravity piping, force main piping and associated valves; furnishing and testing of SCADA system; site restoration including paving, loaming and seeding; installation of a new electrical service; implementation of a traffic management plan; and all appurtenances and incidentals to make a complete and operational pump station unit in accordance with the Contract Documents and the most recent City's Standards.

Sealed bids shall be submitted in strict conformance with the bid document and will be received at 110 Western Avenue, Framingham, MA 01702 until 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, November 21, 2019.

Bid documents will be available for pick-up after 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, October 30, 2019 and may be obtained at the above location or calling 508-532-6026 or by emailing DPWProcurement@FraminghamMa.gov.

The awarded contractor shall comply with Mass. Gen. L. Ch. 149, Sec. 26 – 27D, as this contract is subject to Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Rates.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all submissions, to waive any minor informalities and technicalities, or to cancel the bid if it were in the public interest to do so.
