INVITATION FOR BIDS

BID #: PW-425 ON-CALL ROAD REHABILITATION

The City of Framingham (City), Department of Public Works (DPW), invites sealed bids for the rehabilitation of the asphalt pavement, guardrails, curbs and sidewalks and drainage systems on public roads and/or segments of public roads within the City of Framingham. The work includes a snow plowing requirement and may consist of one or more or any combination of the following construction procedures as determined by the City:

- remove and replace the existing asphalt surface course
- asphalt patching
- asphalt cement and cement concrete sidewalk construction
- wheelchair ramp construction to ADA requirements
- installation of stamped and colored concrete
- installation of stamped asphalt
- associated storm-drainage rehabilitation
- removal and resetting of granite curbing and edging as required, installation of asphalt cement curbs, installation of new granite curbing and edging
- adjustment of street castings to meet grade as required
- removal and application of temporary and permanent traffic markings
- maintenance of traffic signal operations, and replacing traffic control detection wire loops
- loam and seed
- installation of guardrail and chain link fence

THE MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (MASSDOT) HAS PROVIDED A LIST TO THE FRAMINGHAM PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OF APPROVED ELIGIBLE BIDDERS FOR THIS PROJECT. ONLY THOSE CONTRACTORS ON THIS LIST WILL RECEIVE OFFICIAL BID DOCUMENTS. ALL OTHERS WILL BE PROVIDED WITH AN INFORMATIONAL COPY.

Sealed bids shall be submitted in strict conformance with the bid document and will be received at 110 Western Avenue, Framingham, MA 01702 until 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, March 5, 2020.

Bid documents will be available for pick-up after 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, February 19, 2020 at the above location or by calling 508-532-6026 or emailing DPWProcurement@FraminghamMa.gov.

The awarded contractor shall comply with Mass. Gen. L. Ch. 149, Sec. 26 – 27D, as this contract is subject to Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Rates.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all submissions, to waive any minor informalities and technicalities, or to cancel the bid if it were in the public interest to do so.
