## **\*COVID-19 UPDATE\***

### **Nine Additional Residents Test Positive for Virus, Bringing Total to 324,**

*Framingham Learns of Two New Fatalities, Bringing Total to Nine;*

*Health Department Releases Additional Demographic Information*

- **Nine more people test positive for COVID-19 in Framingham:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now 324. With 21 cases recovered and nine fatalities, Framingham currently has 294 active cases. Following the guidance from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, the Framingham Department of Health has not shared any additional information about those who have tested positive because of privacy laws. The Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing).
- **Confirmed Case Data**

| 60-69 years of age | 12%                           |
| 70-79 years of age | 6%                            |
| >80 years of age   | 7%                            |

Almost 90% of all fatalities are 60 year of age and older.

| Long-Term Care Facilities | Percentage of Confirmed Cases |

| Nursing Homes             | 3.4%                          |

| Residential Setting     | Percentage of Confirmed Cases |
|-------------------------|-------------------------------|
| Multi-Unit <sup>1</sup> | 51.5%                         |
| Other <sup>2</sup>      | 48.5%                         |

**Note:**

1. Multi-Unit: residential buildings such as apartments and apartment style condominiums
2. Other: single family homes, townhomes, long-term care facilities, shelters and group homes, and correctional facilities.

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
