COVID-19 UPDATE

**Eleven Additional Residents Test Positive, and 27 People have Recovered from the Virus
*There will be no News Update Monday, May 25***

- **Eleven additional residents test positive for the virus, and 27 more have recovered:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now 1,593. With 793 cases recovered and 86 fatalities, Framingham currently has 714 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Framingham Health Department currently is following 206 residents in quarantine.
