COVID-19 UPDATE

**Since Wednesday, Two Residents have Tested Positive, and
The City has Learned of Two New Fatalities Related to COVID-19;**

Community Hour Tuesday, July 21, at 5 p.m.,

*Focused on Framingham's Older Adults Amid COVID-19: The Past Three+ months and the Future;
Framingham Public Library Extends Hours for Curbside Pickups and Returns*

- **Since Wednesday, two residents have tested positive, and the City has learned of two new fatalities related to COVID-19:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 1,756, there are 119 fatalities. Framingham currently has 79 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 73 residents in quarantine.
