INVITATION FOR BID

PW-441 SUPPLY AND INSTALL TWO MICROWAVE LINKS

The City of Framingham (City), Department of Public Works (DPW), invites bids for the supply and installation of two Cambium PTP820 microwave links on the Massachusetts State Police Headquarters Tower located in Framingham, MA. The original equipment was struck by lightning. Work will include supply, installation and configuration at the Massachusetts State Police Headquarters Tower, and includes furnishing all necessary labor, materials, and equipment necessary to perform the work. The awarded contractor must be able to execute a contract and subsequently perform the work on a priority schedule. A site visit is not mandatory. Contractors who wish to view the site must contact the DPW for an appointment to visit the site with a DPW representative.

Sealed bids shall be submitted electronically in strict conformance with the bid documents through the City of Framingham's Department of Public Works Vendor Registry portal <https://vrapp.vendorregistry.com/Bids/View/BidsList?BuyerId=75c3b765-3725-4b32-9689-fc820e50b9c8> **until 1:00 P.M. on Wednesday, August 12, 2020.**
