**\*COVID-19 UPDATE\***

**Since Wednesday, Eight Residents have Tested Positive for COVID-19, & Three More have Recovered;**

*Reminder: Starting Today, Free, Drive-up COVID-19 Testing Available in Framingham at Keefe Tech*

- **Since Monday, eight residents have tested positive for COVID-19, and three more have recovered:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 1,826. With 1,600 recovered and 121 fatalities, Framingham currently has 105 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 37 residents in quarantine.
- **Starting today, residents will have access to FREE, Drive-up COVID-19 testing at Keefe Tech:**
  - **Location:** Joseph P. Keefe Technical High School, 750 Winter Street (Please note that only the parking area of Keefe Tech will be used for testing, and the building will not be accessible during the testing program.)
  - **Dates:** August 5-14, 2020, Monday - Friday
  - **Hours:** Monday, Wednesday, and Friday – 2-6 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday – 8 a.m.-12 p.m.
  - **Eligibility:** Open to everyone; symptomatic and asymptomatic
  - **Appointment:** No appointment required
  - **Format:** Drive-through only
  - **Cost:** FREE; no insurance required
  - **Test Results:** People will receive results in approximately 72 hours from Fallon Ambulance, who is conducting the tests.
