Beaver Street Bridge to Reopen to Vehicular Traffic and Pedestrians

Framingham, MA – The Framingham Department of Public Works (DPW) is pleased to announce that the [Beaver Street Bridge](#) will reopen to vehicular traffic and pedestrians this evening, Wednesday, September 9.

Construction for the bridge started in late April 2020. The existing bridge structure was demolished and replaced with a new concrete structure. Additional improvements include new water, sewer, and drainage utilities, sidewalks, guardrails, and pavement.

“A project of this magnitude paired with a long duration road closure can be impactful,” said Blake Lukis, Director of Public Works. “The entire DPW team appreciates residents’ and businesses’ patience and cooperation throughout this process.”
