**\*COVID-19 UPDATE\***

**Since Wednesday, 10 Residents have Tested Positive, 12 More have Recovered, and City Learns of One New Fatality Related to COVID-19;**

*Community Outreach Teams in Framingham this Weekend;*

*Community Hour Tuesday, October 20: Update on COVID-19 in Framingham*

- **Since Wednesday, 10 residents have tested positive, 12 more have recovered, and City learns of one new fatality related to COVID-19:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 2,444. With 2,119 recovered and 139 fatalities, Framingham currently has 186 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 158 residents in quarantine.
