ORDER FOR POLE RELOCATION
Order 2020-086

By the City Council of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts notice having been given and a public hearing held, as provided by law, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

That permission be and hereby granted **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND INC. and EVERSOURCE (NSTAR ELECTRIC)** joint or identical locations for an permission to erect and maintain poles and their respective wires and cables to be placed thereon, together with anchors, guys and other sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Companies may deem necessary, in the public way or ways as requested in petition of said Companies dated the 27th day of August 2020:

LELAND STREET: Relocate one (1) jointly owned pole numbered T.15/E.15 to a point on the southeasterly side of Leland Street approximately five hundred sixty-six (566) feet northeasterly from the center line of Weld Street.

1 JO Pole to be relocated

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the conditions set forth in a letter dated August 28, 2020 from the Framingham Department of Public Works as follows:

1. The applicant shall call Dig-Safe to mark out the location of the water main before construction.
2. The proposed utility pole shall be installed a minimum five feet away from City utilities. DPW requests notification prior to the start of work to verify final location in the field.
3. All work shall conform to the City of Framingham construction standards.
4. The proposed work shall be inspected by the City of Framingham DPW to verify that no public utilities are adversely affected.
5. The area in the vicinity of the work shall be restored and all excess excavation resulting from pole setting shall be removed by the Grantee.

The following general conditions shall also apply: Pole shall be of sound timber, and reasonably straight and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the Petition Plan marked – **VERIZON No. 4A0MQ0G**, dated August 26, 2020 filed with said petition. There may be attached to said pole by said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** not to exceed 20 wires and 5 cables and by said **EVSOURCE (NSTAR ELECTRIC)** any such wires, cables and fixtures as are necessary in its business and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height in compliance with the National Electrical Safety Code.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC. and NSTAR ELECTRIC (EVSOURCE)** to lay and maintain underground conduits, manholes, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as may be desired for distributing purposes.

I hereby certify that the foregoing order was adopted at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Framingham, Massachusetts held on the 15th day of September, 2020.

It is noted that, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this meeting and public hearing was held with City Council members via teleconferencing. The meeting is available for viewing on the City of Framingham website under Government Channel.



The Department of Public Works (DPW) is in receipt of a request from Verizon New England, Inc. to relocate existing pole, wire, cables and fixtures, including the necessary anchors, guys and other such sustaining and protecting fixtures to be owned and used in common by your petitioners, along and across the following public way or ways of Leland Street in support of the jointly owned pole T.15/E.15. This infrastructure will be located on the public way of Leland Street as represented under submitted Grant of Location application package dated August 26, 2020.

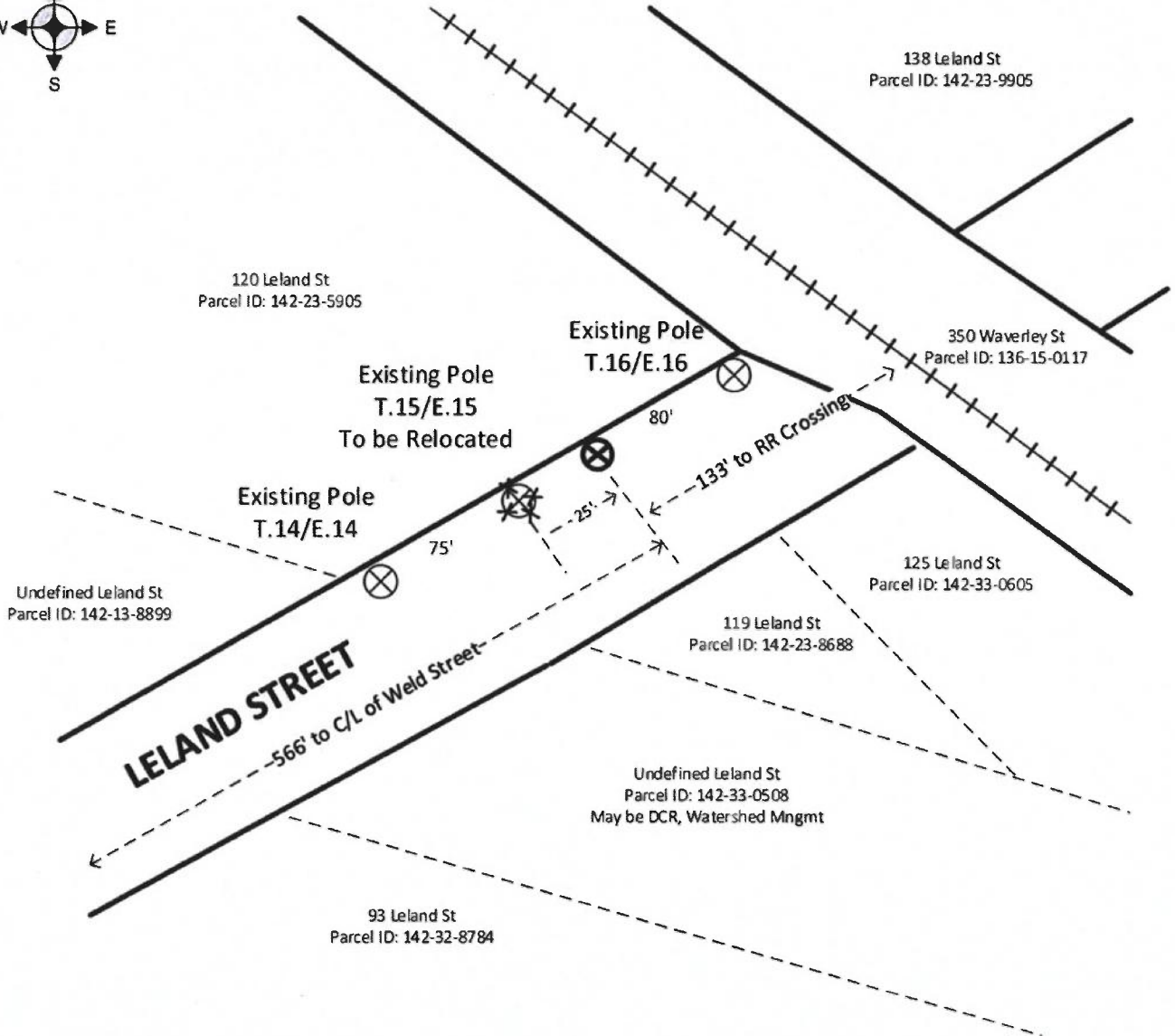
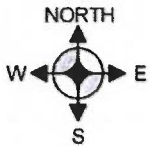


PETITION PLAN
