**\*COVID-19 UPDATE\***

**Since Monday, 31 Residents have Tested Positive, 16 More have Recovered, and City Learns of One New Fatality Associated with COVID-19;**

*Drive-through Testing at Walsh Middle School Ends Saturday, Oct. 31, and Resumes Monday, Nov. 2, at New Location – The TJX Companies, Inc. Offices - (Entrance to the Testing Site is on Speen Street near the Mass Pike Exit Ramp Overpass)*

- **Since Monday, 31 residents have tested positive, 16 more have recovered, and the City learns of one new fatality associated with COVID-19:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 2,586. With 2,248 recovered and 146 fatalities, Framingham currently has 192 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 136 residents in quarantine.
- **Free, drive-through COVID-19 testing ends at Walsh Middle School Saturday, Oct. 31, and resumes on Monday, Nov. 2, at TJX offices**
  - Location: 770 Cochituate Road, Framingham, MA 01701 (entrance to the testing site is on Speen Street near the Mass Pike exit ramp overpass)
  - Date: Starting Monday, Nov. 2
  - Days/Time: Monday to Saturday– 10 a.m.-2 p.m.
  - Eligibility: Open to everyone; symptomatic and asymptomatic
  - Appointment: No appointment required
  - Format: Drive-through only
  - Cost: FREE; no health insurance required
  - Test Results: People will receive results in approximately 72 hours from Fallon Ambulance, who is conducting the tests.
