COVID-19 UPDATE

Since Wednesday, 69 Residents have Tested Positive, and 15 More have Recovered from COVID-19;

Community Outreach Teams in Framingham this Weekend

- **Since Wednesday, 69 residents have tested positive, and 15 more have recovered from COVID-19:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 2,899. With 2,425 recovered and 153 fatalities, Framingham currently has 321 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 196 residents in quarantine.

 - 10 a.m.-1 p.m.: Business walk along Howard St. to hand out flyers and distribute window signs and stacks of literature to businesses
 - 1:30-4:30 p.m.: Care Kit Drops at Alta Union House (55 Concord St.)
