COVID-19 UPDATE

**Since Friday, November 13, 93 Residents have Tested Positive, and
61 More have Recovered from COVID-19;**

Health Department Distributes Demographic COVID-19 Data;

Community Hour Tuesday, November 17: Focused on Framingham's New Sustainability Commission

- **Since Friday, November 13, 93 residents have tested positive and 61 more have recovered from COVID-19:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 2,992. With 2,486 recovered and 153 fatalities, Framingham currently has 353 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 211 residents in quarantine.
- **The City's Department of Public Health distributes demographic COVID-19 data on all confirmed cases in Framingham since March 1, 2020:** Data includes information on confirmed cases by age, gender, race/ethnicity, fatalities, nursing homes, and residential settings.
