ORDER NO. 2020-101 REQUEST OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the favorable vote of the Traffic Commission on July 28, 2020, the City Council now votes to establish a <u>No Parking restriction</u> on both sides of Marble Street from the intersection with Blandin Avenue proceeding north and terminating approximately two hundred seventy (270) feet at the intersection of the southern driveway at 1 Marble Street as depicted on the attachment. All documentation is available from the Traffic Commission.

That, in accordance with the favorable vote of the Traffic Commission on July 28, 2020, the City Council also votes to <u>establish a STOP SIGN</u> at both terminations of Marble Street as it intersects to the north with Waverly Street and as it intersects to the south with Blandin Avenue as depicted on the attachment. All documentation is available from the Traffic Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

Pursuant to Article V Section 6 of the Framingham Home Rule Charter, Schedule 1 (No Parking) of Article V Section 2 of the Framingham Traffic Rules and Orders, originally adopted on September 9, 1973, shall be amended by adding:

Street	Side of Street	Extending From
Marble Street	Both	Blandin Avenue for 270 feet North

Also, pursuant to Article V Section 6 of the Framingham Home Rule Charter, Schedule 2 (Stop Signs) of Article VIII Section 10 of the Framingham Traffic Rules and Orders, originally adopted on September 9, 1973, shall be amended by adding:

Street Stopped – Marble Street northbound at through street Waverly Street Street Stopped – Marble Street southbound at through street Blandin Avenue

Pursuant to the Framingham Home Rule Charter, Article V Section 6, all rules and regulations promulgated by authorized vote of the Traffic Commission shall become effective on the 30th day following the day on which notice of proposed rule or regulation is filed with the council, unless the council shall within such period by majority of the full council vote to reject such rule or regulation or has sooner voted to affirm it. In accordance with the council's vote, this change is effective on November 28, 2020.
