ORDER NO. 2020-099 REQUEST OF THE CHIEF ASSESSOR AND THE BOARD OF ASSESSORS

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE CHIEF ASSESSOR AND THE BOARD OF ASSESSORS, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

That, after diligent review and after hearing public input at a duly posted and advertised public hearing on November 5, 2020, the City Council now votes to adopt a Residential Factor of 0.8029/ CIP shift 1.72 for tax burden options for Fiscal Year 2021.

Incumbent in this vote the City Council specifies that it does not adopt any of the three annual options of Open Space Class 2, Small Commercial Exemption or Residential Exemption for Fiscal Year 2021.
