COVID-19 UPDATE

Since Monday, 45 Residents have Tested Positive, and 44 More have Recovered from COVID-19;
Reminder: Stop the Spread COVID-19 Drive-through Testing at TJX Companies, Inc., and SMOC Walk-up Testing Schedules Modified for Thanksgiving Week Due to Holiday Closure of the Testing Lab;
City Hall Closed Thursday, Nov. 26, & Friday, Nov. 27, in Observance of Thanksgiving

- **Since Monday, 45 residents have tested positive, and 44 more have recovered from COVID-19:**
The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 3,219. With 2,667 recovered and 155 fatalities, Framingham currently has 397 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 263 residents in quarantine.
