COVID-19 UPDATE

Since Wednesday, 191 Residents have Tested Positive, 29 More have Recovered, and City Learns of One New Fatality Associated with COVID-19;

Free COVID-19 Drive-through Testing at TJX Companies, Inc., Canceled Saturday, December 5, Due to Inclement Weather;

State to Deploy "Community Outreach Teams" to Framingham this Weekend

- **Since Wednesday, 191 residents have tested positive, 29 more have recovered, and the City learns of one new fatality associated with COVID-19:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 3,706. With 2,825 recovered and 160 fatalities, Framingham currently has 721 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 326 residents in quarantine.
- **Free COVID-19 drive-through testing at TJX at 770 Cochituate Road is canceled Saturday, December 5, due to inclement weather.**
- **Community Outreach Teams in Framingham this weekend to increase COVID-19 education:**

Anticipated Schedule for Saturday, December 5:

- 10:30 a.m.-2 p.m.: Business walk along Hollis St. and Main St. to hand out flyers and distribute window signs and literature to businesses
- 12-4 p.m.: Care kit drops to Kendall Green Condominium (10-12 Kendall St.) and Arlington Commons (77-79 Arlington St.). Organizers go door to door and leave a bag of educational materials, masks, and disinfectant wipes at each home.

Anticipated Schedule for Sunday, December 6:

- 10:30 a.m.-2 p.m.: Business walk along Hollis St. and Main St. to hand out flyers and distribute window signs and literature to businesses
- 12-4 p.m.: Care Kit Drops at Bishop Commons (100 Bishop Dr.).
