COVID-19 TESTING UPDATE

Correction - On Friday, City to Restart Free Walk-up Testing Noon-4 p.m. at SMOC for Framingham Residents Only

*Reminder: All Free COVID-19 Testing **Canceled Thursday, December 17**, Due to Inclement Weather*

- **On Friday, City to restart free walk-up testing noon-4 p.m. at South Middlesex Opportunity Council (SMOC) for Framingham residents only: There had been plans to resume walk-up testing at SMOC today, but because of staffing challenges, walk-up testing will resume Friday.** Originally, the walk-up testing site at SMOC was one of the State's free Stop the Spread testing sites, open to all Massachusetts residents. Because some in the City do not have a vehicle, the Office of the Mayor and Health Department Leadership wanted to keep the walk-up testing available. Framingham reached an agreement with Transformative Healthcare to use CARES Act funds to keep the walk-up testing site running for **residents only**.
 - **Location:** South Middlesex Opportunity Council (SMOC), 7 Bishop Street, Framingham
 - **Hours:** Monday through Friday, noon-4 p.m.
 - **Eligibility:** Open to Framingham residents; symptomatic and asymptomatic (Proof of residency may be required to be tested.)
 - **Appointment:** No appointment required
 - **Format:** Walk-up (limited parking available on-site)
 - **Cost:** FREE; no health insurance required
 - **Test Results:** Residents will receive results in approximately 24 to 48 hours from Transformative Healthcare, who is conducting the tests.
