COVID-19 UPDATE

Since Friday, January 15, 136 Residents have Tested Positive, 117 More have Recovered, and City Learns of One New Fatality Associated with COVID-19;

Weekly Food Resource Guide During Current COVID-19 Surge;

This Week, the Health Department Will Distribute Weekly COVID-19 Demographic Data Wednesday

- **Since Friday, January 15, 136 residents have tested positive, 117 more have recovered, and the City learns of one new fatality associated with COVID-19:** The number of people in the City who have tested positive for COVID-19 is 5,857. With 4,452 recovered and 194 fatalities, Framingham currently has 1,211 active cases. The Framingham Health Department contacts the people who were potentially exposed and the owners of the businesses or places of employment where the potential exposures occurred to inform and counsel them on next steps (contact tracing). In addition to the active cases, the Health Department is following 558 residents in quarantine.
- **Weekly food resource guide during current COVID-19 surge:** To better manage the food demand during the current COVID-19 surge, Framingham's Emergency Food Line's coordinators have developed a weekly guide about food availability for residents.
