- 65% of Framingham's Population has Received the COVID-19 Vaccine:** According to [2019 U.S. Census](#) numbers, Framingham had a population of 74,416. As the City's [data report from July 21, 2021, noted](#), 48,441 people in the City are fully vaccinated, which equates to 65%. When we get the final 2020 Census numbers, the City will provide an update.
