- Whereas,** The residents of Framingham appreciate our entire health army for everything that was done for the residents of Framingham during an unimaginably difficult and prolonged crisis;
- Whereas,** Residents want to recognize the phenomenal, gifted leadership of our Board of Health, our Public Health Nurses and our volunteer army that fought to protect the residents of Framingham from the devastating consequences of the COVID virus;
- WHEREAS,** Because of their efforts, Framingham was one of only a few cities in Massachusetts that didn't need the Community Tracing Collaborative, because Framingham's efforts were so well coordinated;
