REQUEST OF THE FRAMINGHAM PUBLIC SCHOOLS

UPON THE REQUEST OF THE FRAMINGHAM PUBLIC SCHOOLS, THE CITY OF FRAMINGHAM, THROUGH THE FRAMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, IT IS SO ORDERED:

Having convened in an open meeting on March 15, 2022, prior to the SOI submission closing date, the Framingham City Council, in accordance with its charter, by-laws, and ordinances, has voted to authorize the Superintendent to submit to the Massachusetts School Building Authority the Statement of Interest Form dated March 15, 2022 for the Potter Road Elementary School located at 492 Potter Rd, Framingham, MA 01701 and for the Charlotte A. Dunning Elementary School located at 48 Frost St, Framingham, MA 01701 which describes and explains the following deficiencies and the priority category(s) for which an application may be submitted to the Massachusetts School Building Authority in the future:

The roofs of both schools meet the age requirements for potential MSBA funding (25 years old or older) and are identified in the District's long range roof replacement program as priorities.

The Potter Road Elementary School roof was repaired in 2018 with an extended 5-year warranty that expires in 2023. Visually, roofing appears to show leaks in numerous locations that have contributed to the premature deterioration of architectural finishes throughout the building. Although the major leaks have been repaired, there are ongoing leaks that occur throughout the building that have required a number of repairs and disrupted school operations at times.

The Charlotte A. Dunning Elementary School roof was repaired in 2018 with an extended 5 year warranty that expires in 2023. Visually, roofing appears to show leaks in numerous locations that have contributed to the premature deterioration of architectural finishes throughout the building. Although the major leaks have been repaired, there are ongoing leaks that occur throughout the building that have required a number of repairs and ceiling tile replacements.
