

License to Carry/FID Card Information:



The Framingham Police Department accepts all new and renewal firearms license applications in person at the Framingham Police Department Records Bureau during normal business hours M-F 8:00-12:30. If you previously held a Class B or FID Card and would like to apply for a Class A, this is considered a NEW license. Class B licenses have been phased out by the state. Consistent with current laws, the FPD only issues unrestricted licenses.

RENEWALS:

Necessary paperwork for renewal applications will include the following: completed and signed application, copy of your driver's license, and proof of residency. Examples of proof of residency are: copy of utility bills (gas, water, cable, electric, etc.) or voter registration certificate (from City Clerk). *We do not accept any documents from the registry of motor vehicles, tax bills, credit card transactions, or records where the applicant can request that information be delivered to a specific address.* Ownership of property does not demonstrate residency. We accept \$100 cash only; no personal checks. Renewals for residents seventy (70) years old and over are free. Renewals do not require a secondary visit for fingerprints or photographs.

NEW APPLICATIONS:

Necessary paperwork for new applications will include the following: completed and signed application, copy of your driver's license, proof of residency. New applications also require proof of citizenship such as a birth certificate, U.S. passport, or naturalization certificate. Examples of proof of residency are: copy of utility bills (water, electric, etc.) or voter registration certificate (from City Clerk). *We do not accept any documents from the registry of motor vehicles, tax bills, credit card transactions, or records where the applicant can request that information be delivered to a specific address.* Ownership of property does not demonstrate residency. Additionally, for new applicants we will need all the aforementioned items as well as a copy of the safety course certificate. Active members of the U.S. Military branches are exempt from the safety class and will be required to produce their military ID when submitting the application. New applicants will be scheduled for a fingerprint and photograph appointment when submitting the application. A personal interview of all new LTC applicants will be conducted during the photo/print visit. Please ensure that you include a current email address and phone number with voicemail on the application. We accept \$100 cash only; no personal checks.

New applicants: No payment is required during your initial application submission. Please bring the payment on the day you are interviewed, fingerprinted, and photographed. These appointments are conducted by appointment on Tuesdays and Thursdays during business hours.
